## Curriculum

In English, we will be using text-based writing and exploring the book 'Holes - by Louis Sachar' to inspire a newspaper report, a diary entry and a letter.

Mathematics this term focuses on fractions with different denominators, dividing fractions and ratio.
Our topic this term is Geography based and is gaining an understanding of 'America'. We will be exploring North and South America, looking at their different climate zones and how they compare to Lincolnshire.

Science focuses on 'circulatory system-hearts and lungs'. During Science we will be exploring the different components that make up our circulatory system, the role blood has to play and how oxygen is circulated around the body.

Alongside these exciting lessons and subjects, we will also be exploring new ideas in RE (expressing beliefs through Arts), Music (Choral singing), Art (Artists of North America), Computing (designing a website), MFL, PE (Dance) and PHSE (Health and Wellbeing).

## Reading

We really want to have a bigger push on reading, with more children reading at home. Please encourage your child to read at home and then sign their reading record. Please ensure your child brings in their Reading Record and current reading book to school every day as this will enable us to monitor your child's reading development and progress throughout the term and year.

## Physical Education (P.E)

This term PE will be on a Monday afternoon and Wednesday morning (swimming) until $\mathbf{2 2}^{\text {nd }}$ November then it will change to a Friday afternoon with JB sports, we will be working on Dance. Please ensure your child has a complete P.E. kit (white T-shirt and blue/black shorts) in school suitable for both indoor and outdoor PE i.e. tracksuit bottoms. As items of clothing are regularly 'misplaced', please ensure each item of clothing is clearly labelled. Please ensure children have a PE
kit in school all week as there may be times when PE kit is required on non-PE days, it also helps towards any clubs children do if they forget their clothes for a club.
