Summer Term Two

We welcome you back to school after the last few months of home schooling. I know there may be uncertainty, worry and a sense of anxiousness, but please be assured we are doing all health and safety measures to keep your children safe.

Our Curriculum

This term in our Central 'Bubble', we are going to try and have a sense of normality by planning lessons like we would usually. Our topic is Around the World in **Geography for year 2** and The Commonwealth for **Year 3**, we are going to focus on the world map, continents and oceans and how the commonwealth fits into that. Our **Art** is going to be looking at different art around the world such as West Indian Art.

In English, Year 2 - our book that we are focusing on this term is 'The Upside- Down Lion'. This book is a fable and we will be using this to see how stories can teach lessons as well as looking at how characters feel and the emotions.

Year 3 – Our first book is 'The Tempest' by William Shakespeare, we will be exploring this story and writing a newspaper report based on the story. Our second book is 'Just so stories' by Rudyard Kiplin – we will be using this book to write our own story. Children **will not** be accessing the library.

Maths – Year 2 - We are starting off the term by looking at addition and subtraction and word problems.

Year 3 – We are starting off the term by looking at formal multiplication and then going onto working with fractions. We will continue using Busy Ant maths as well as challenging ourselves through reasoning and problem-solving challenges and daily arithmetic.

RE, PHSE, Science -This term, we are going to focus on 'What makes a good life?', is the meaning of a good life the same for everybody? In PHSE, we will be focusing on emotions, feelings and what makes us special and unique. We will also be completing many lessons which support positive mental health and well-being, especially during the first couple of weeks. In **Science** we are learning about plants and the plant life cycle.

PE - We will be taking on a curriculum area with JB Sports on a **Thursday** afternoon. Children **can** come into school on this day wearing P.E kit., it is going to be delivered outside so children may want to wear tracksuit bottoms and jumpers if it's a bit chilly.
