#### Dear Families,

It has been a very busy time for the children and staff as the end-of-year assessments and screening checks come to a close in Reception, Year 2 and Year 6. Everyone has worked tirelessly and has given 100%. We expect the vast majority of the children to have made good progress and I will share our data with you when all of the results are finalised in July. The children in the other year groups are taking part in internal assessments over the next fortnight and we will be able to share your child's progress and attainment with you in the end-of-year reports.

Our transition events for our new Reception children are currently taking place. It was lovely to meet some of our new families and we are delighted that they have chosen The Emmaus Federation as their school of choice. We do still have some places left at Swineshead, so if you know of a family who wants to send their child to a school that cares deeply about their child and wants to give them the very best education possible, please do not hesitate to contact us.

We have a number of classes on school trips this term. All of the trips are linked to the topic they are learning about and photos and commentary from the trips are available on Class Dojo.

The Federation has placed a significant investment into curriculum standards in 2018 – 2019. A new mathematics scheme called 'Busy Ant Maths' will be rolled-out from September and teaching staff are getting familiarised with it this term. The scheme allows for teachers to deliver challenging yet engaging lessons that are pitched purely at age-related expectations. It is accompanied by a set of challenge books, problem solving and reasoning activities, homework tasks and information guides for parents. We have also invested in a reading programme called Accelerated Reader. Children in KS2 are given weekly quizzes and comprehension tasks on the books that they are reading at home and in school. The programme also identifies what level of challenge your child should be reading. There's quite a bit of preparation work for the school in order to be ready for September, but a 'Tiger Team' has been put to task to ensure all of this work is ready? Accelerated Reader is regarded as one of the best reading comprehension programme across the schools.

Our kwik-cricket teams took part in a fantastic festival on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> June. The weather stayed kind and every child demonstrated excellent team skills and was a credit to their respective schools.

Sutterton was delighted to bring home some silver wear with a second place position and all of the children had a wonderful sporting development opportunity, facilitated by the Boston and District Sports Partnership. Our football teams, led by Mr Cook and Mr Shaw, have been playing in league fixtures with other local schools. They have equipped themselves well in every match with some impressive wins. Notably, both schools scoring numerous successive goals against St Bart's.

A great event in the sporting calendar is the Thomas Cowley Sports Day. We filled a 52-seater coach, which meant more children could compete and there was real school camaraderie. Rather than a more traditional Sports Day, this was a pure athletic competitive event of track and field. I think it's fair to say that both schools have a strong association with rugby. The sport is sadly not played by many primaries; however, we take the game very seriously, having a number of staff that are avid rugby fans and trained referees and officials. We are hosting our own festival at Swineshead on 19th June and it promises to be a great event. A real feather in our cap is that Mrs Webster, rugby coach and Change 4 Life (C4L) Coordinator at Sutterton, has been invited to bring her C4L team to represent Boston and District at the Lincolnshire School Games. The children will take part in a carousel of events and join in with an event designed to celebrate the best in Lincolnshire sport. We are very proud of the accomplishments of our children who compete in a number of sporting disciplines outside of school. We look forward to children sharing their efforts and successes with us at
